PLEASE NOTE:

A partial refund of the total fees (minus the \$75 deposit) will **only** be given if requested in writing by July 01, 2019. Refunds must be approved by the 4-H staff. Refunds will not be processed until the end of the camping season in late July. Refunds will not be issued for students who leave camp early regardless of whether it is due to illness, conduct, etc.

If your child arrives at a 4-H event/activity with an untreated contagious illness, or is diagnosed at the event with a contagious illness, you will be asked to pick them up immediately. You will also be contacted if the child has a fever, to determine the course of action. Contagious illnesses could include but are not limited to: head lice, pink eye, mononucleosis, strep throat, flu, or ring worm.

There will be a \$35 charge on all checks returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

4-H'ers sign a Code of Conduct prior to camp and are expected to abide by these behavior standards.

AT CAMP...

The schedule at Rock Eagle is filled throughout the week of July 8-12, 2019. Campers take part in what is called a Major Interest Class for about 1-1/2 hours each day (Tuesday-Thursday). On the registration form, you will rank the options for the Major Interest Classes. Major Interest Class options include: archery, entomology, forestry, herpetology, lake ecology, or wildlife.

Campers (except those in swim instruction) will have the opportunity to canoe and participate in the "Health's Our Pledge" (H.O.P.) class on nutrition and exercise. All campers have the opportunity to enjoy one of two swimming pools during "free time". Please carefully read the information about swim instruction (below).

Swim instruction class is only for the students who have NO ABILITY to maneuver themselves in the water. Students who take swim instruction DO NOT take canoe class or H.O.P class due to the time involved with swim instruction.
